Position Description

Housing Maintenance Technician

Position Description: Saunders Brothers is a wholesale nursery and orchard operation in central Virginia. Saunders Brothers is looking for someone who is willing to oversee the repair and maintenance of employee housing. Will also assist in maintenance and construction of greenhouses.

Requirements and Duties:

- Oversee the maintenance, renovation, and construction of employee housing.
- Assist in the construction and maintenance of greenhouses.
- Assist in the installation, maintenance, and repair of pump houses and irrigation systems.
- Assist in the repair and maintenance of buildings.
- Communicate inventory levels as needed of construction materials and tools and keep them in proper working condition.
- Able to lift 75 lbs. and be able spend at least 8 hours per day standing. In addition, must be able to stoop, bend, kneel, squat, and twist around for at least 8 hours per day. Must be able to work outside in all types of weather.
- Able to read a tape measure, safely operate construction hand and power tools, climb ladders, and be physically able to perform other construction tasks.
- Able to prioritize workload and have flexibility as work demands change.
- Work independently and cooperatively with other members of the maintenance team and direct the work of other team members as assigned.
- Work with other employees who do not speak English and be open to learning Spanish.
- Have good math skills.
- Have good communication and listening skills and be able to effectively work with entire staff at Saunders Brothers.
- Work Saturdays and after hours, as necessary.
- Perform other duties as needed.

Qualifications:

- Must have a high school diploma or equivalent GED or a combination of technical schooling/training and experience in plumbing, construction, maintenance, and electrical/ mechanical work.
- Must have a valid driver's license and must provide a copy of driving record (DMV) at time of application.
